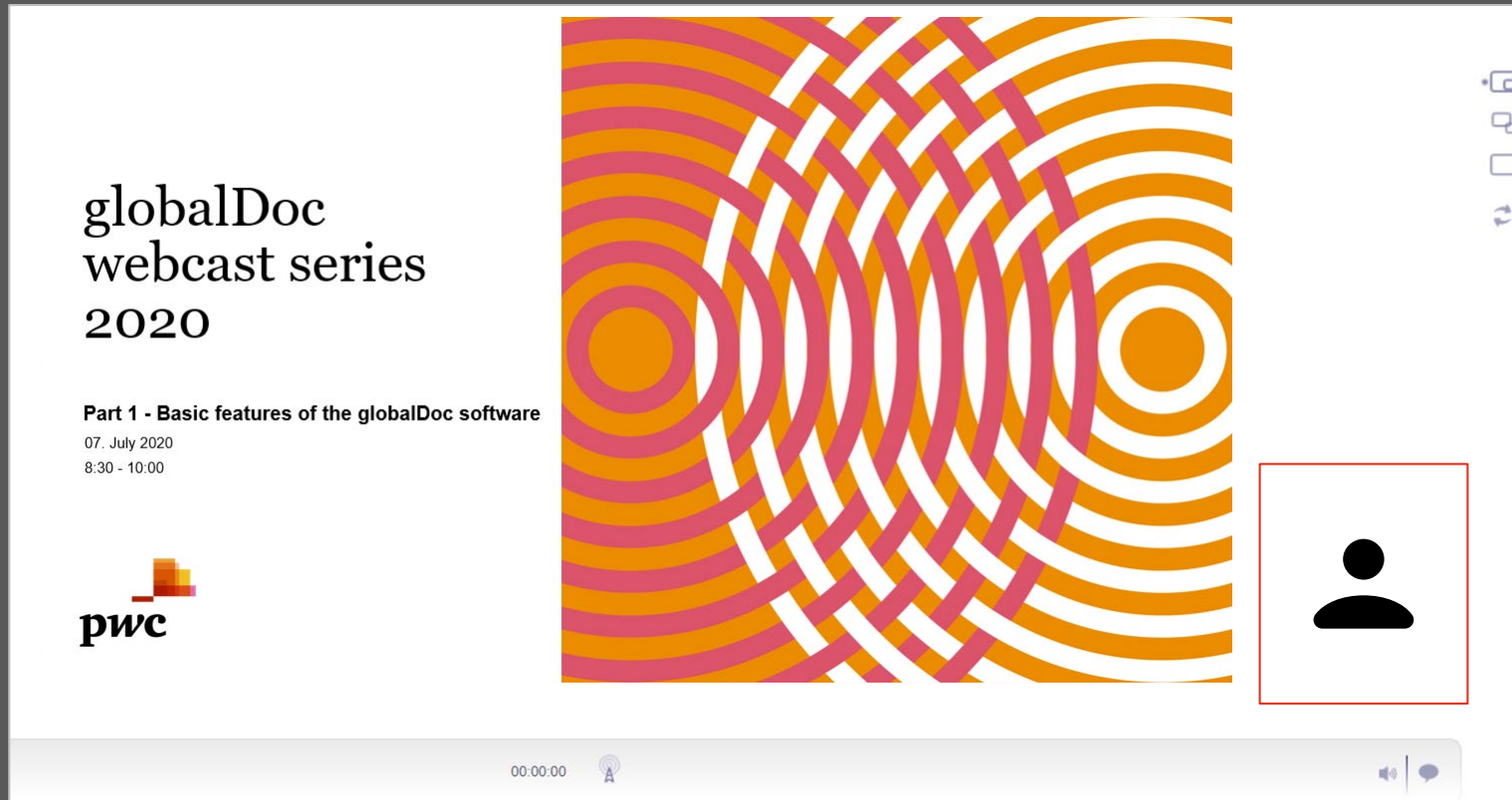

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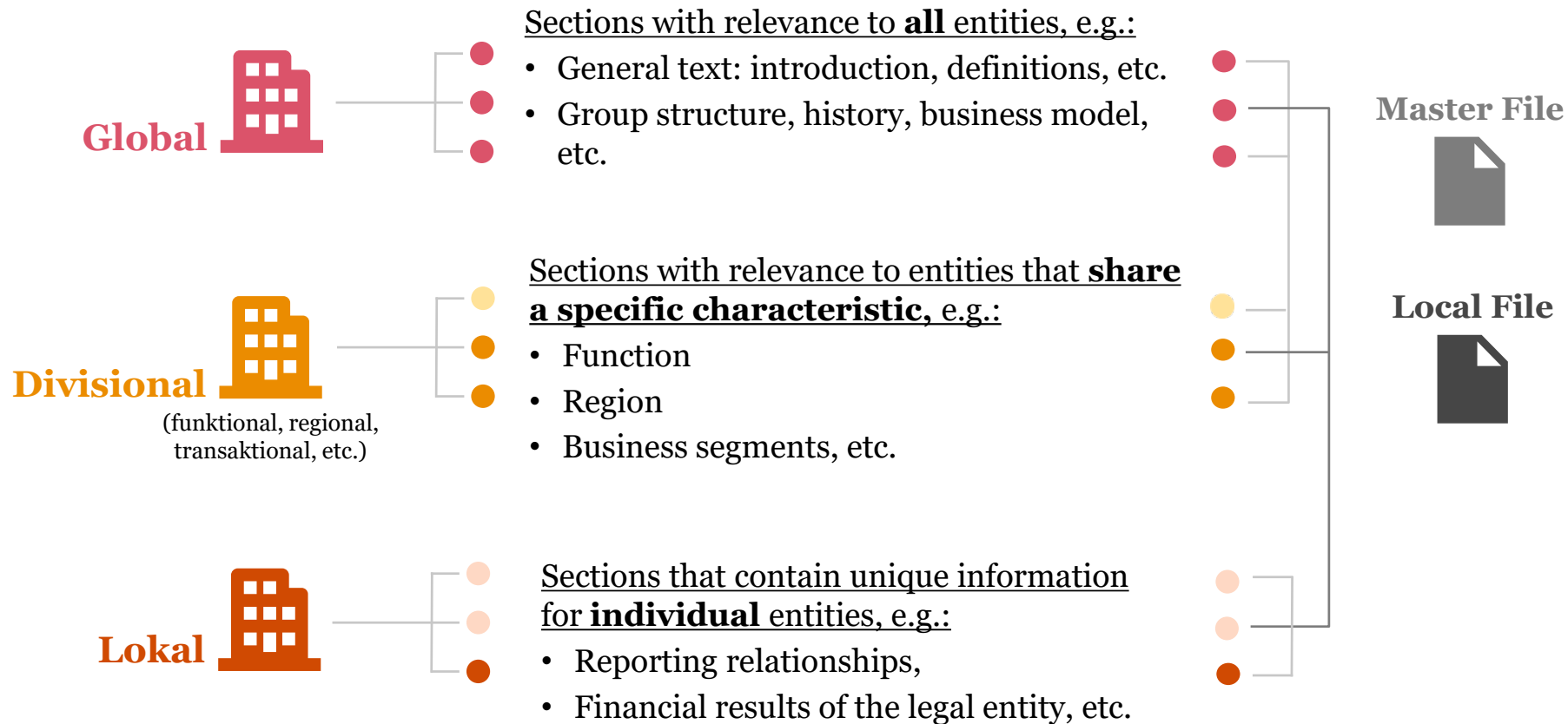

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What is globalDoc

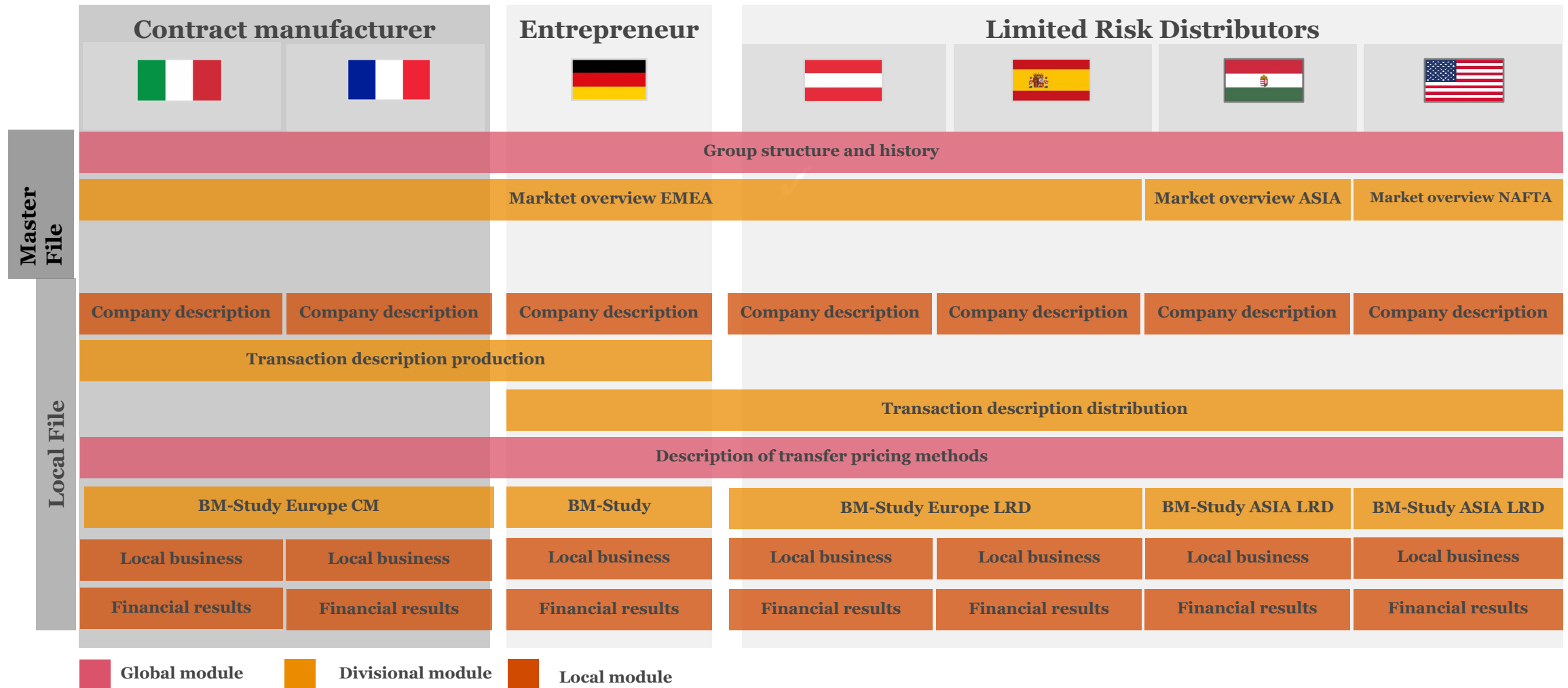
From information to module to documentation



Your advantages of the Modular Approach

- Any group structure can be represented.
- Content is prepared once and can be assigned to all, multiple or a single company.
- All modules can be combined individually to create a standardized yet flexible documentation report.
- The system can be adapted and scaled to a new environment.

Modular setup of your documentation (example)



Connecting modules with content, information and data

Texte



abcd

- Two options for text processing: in-tool editor and MS Word
- Permanent traceability of contents, all changes are tracked (who, when, what)
- Previous versions are available
- (Internal) back-up information can be archived together with the documentation content

✓ **Prevention of redundancies**

Variables



- Import of I/C transaction matrices and (segmented) profit and loss statements
- Import of lists as Excel/CSV files (companies, users, etc.)
- Central management of benchmarking results

✓ **Consistent data**

Attachments

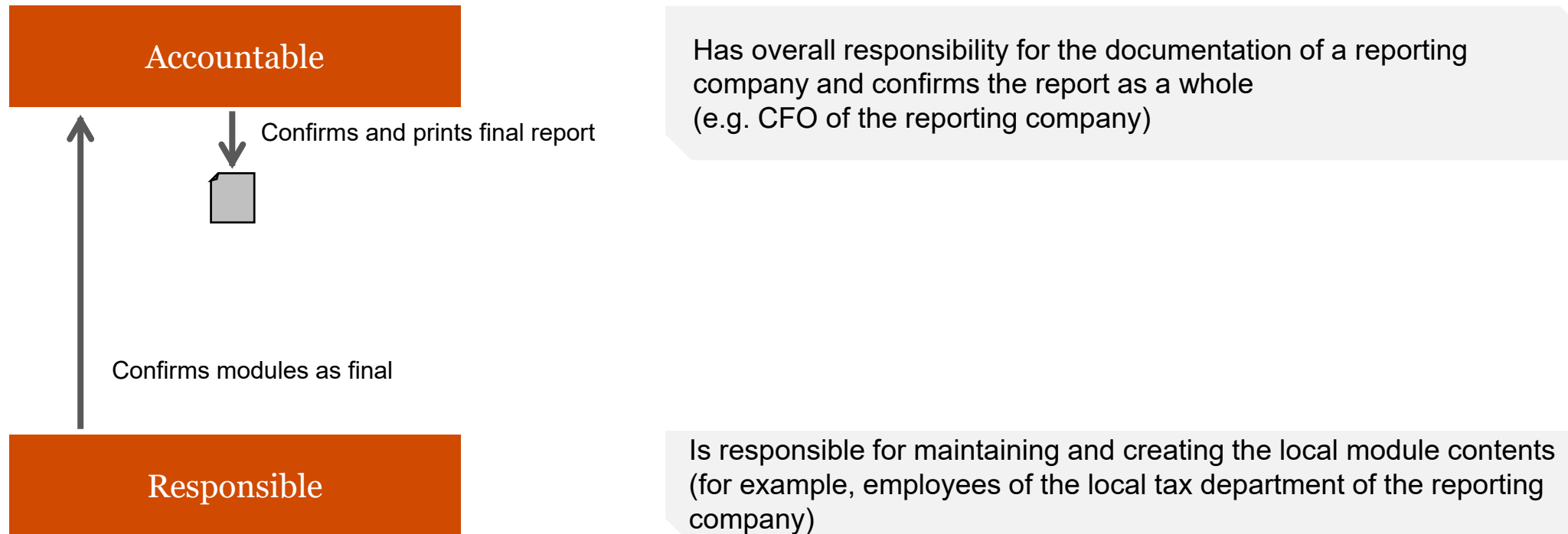


- Information can be attached in any format (e.g. PowerPoint, PDF, Excel, email)
- Different use of the data, e.g. as an appendix to the TP documentation or as data storage for internal background information

✓ **Central file storage**

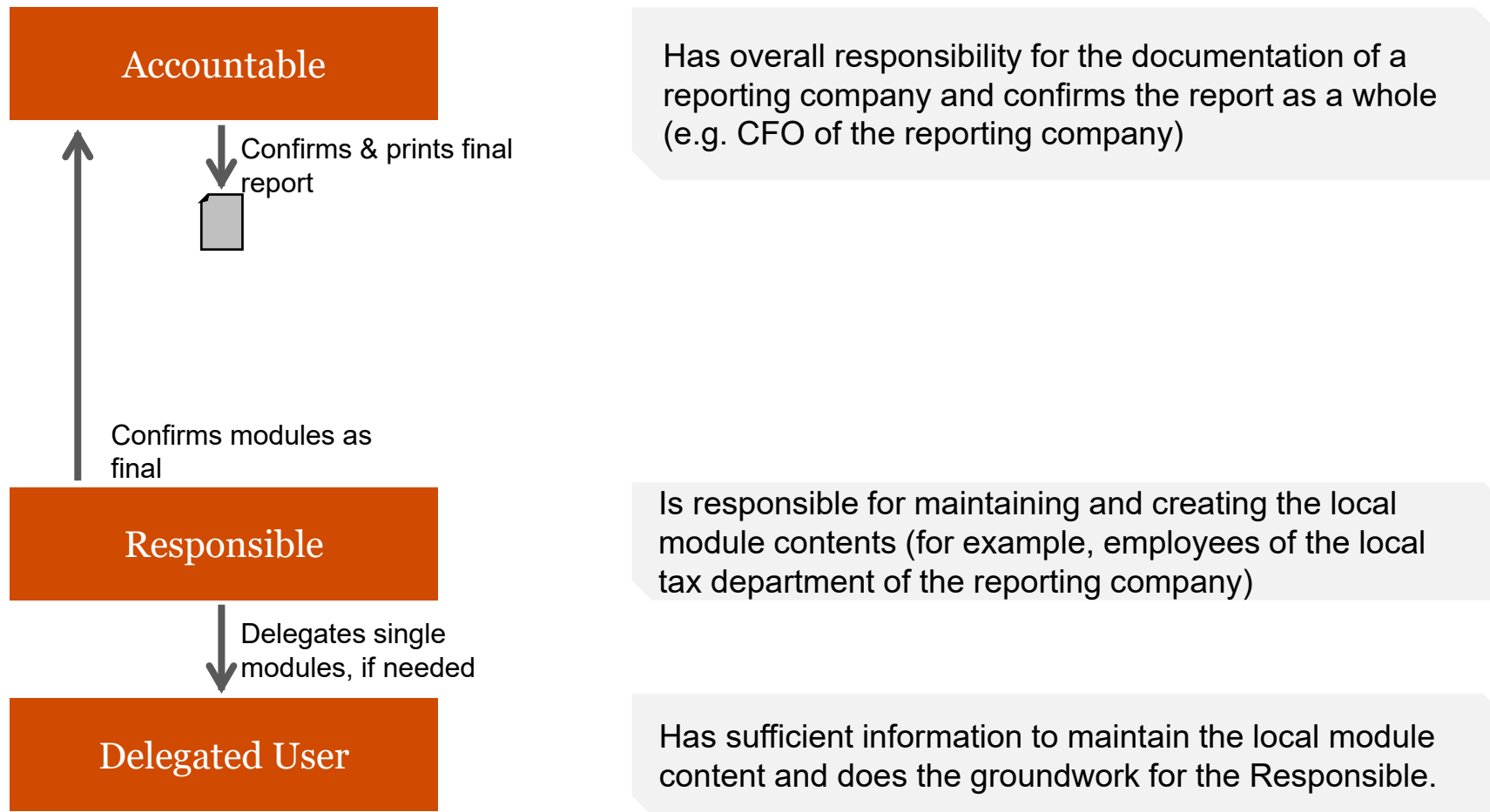
User roles (according to RACI)



Note: Accountable and Responsible can be the same person!

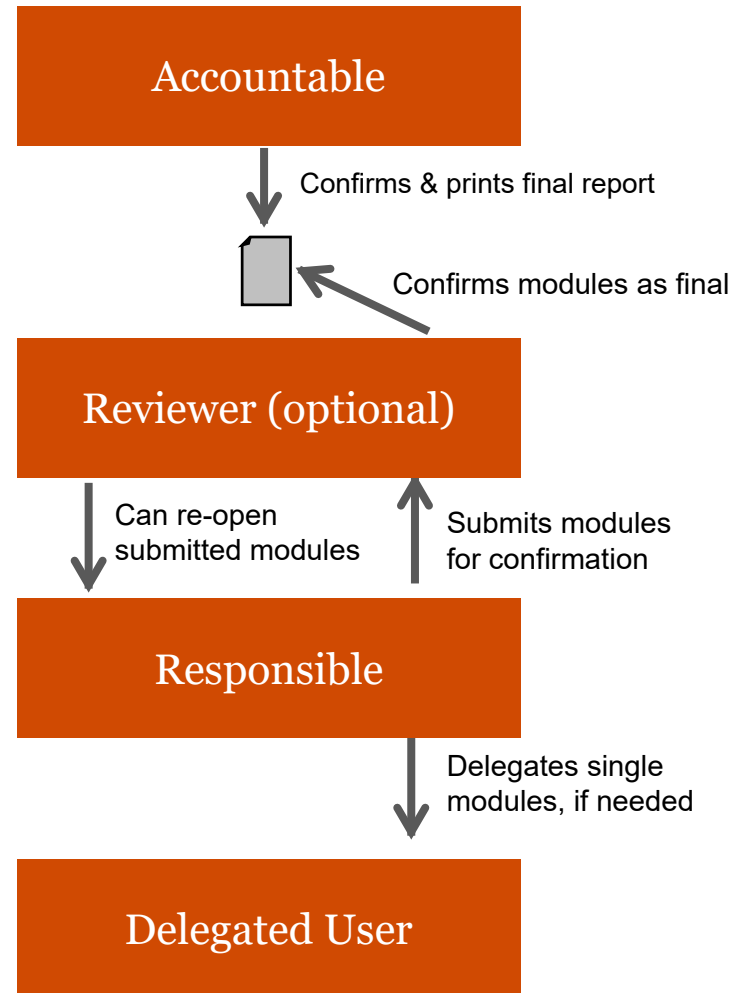
New user roles in globalDoc 8.0

New user roles in globalDoc 8.0

User roles (according to RACI)



Has overall responsibility for the documentation of a reporting company and confirms the report as a whole (e.g. CFO of the reporting company)

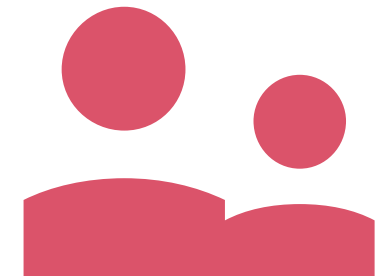
Optional: Reviews content of the local modules (e.g. employee of the central tax department)

Is responsible for maintaining and creating the local module contents (e.g. employees of the local tax department of the reporting company)

Has sufficient information to maintain the local module content and does the groundwork for the Responsible

Additional user rights

- Read rights
- Write permissions
- Editor rights/editing rights
- Print rights



New features in globalDoc version 8.5

- Improved comment function in the intool-Editor
- Possibility of direct task creation with module creation
- New language (Italian) available
- Flexibilisation with automatic allocation of modules by transaction group
- Possibility to insert variables over the whole report
- Checklist for individual modules for processing subtasks
- Automatic adaptation of currencies to countries
- Adding a “draft”- watermark in unfinalized reports
- Display of shareholders as variable
- Expansion of the questionnaire with new question types
